

Salt and Cyanotype Materials List through Stills Online Learning with Brittonie Fletcher

Materials List:

- Ferric Ammonium Citrate (100g+)
- Potassium Ferricyanide (100g+)
- Silver Nitrate (10g+)
- Sodium Chloride (Salt: non iodised, with no anti-caking agents) (10g+)
- Sodium Thiosulfate (500g+)

- 3 x Small liquid proof opaque or brown bottles (50ml each or more)
- 1 x Large liquid proof bottle (500ml or more)
- Brushes (sponge / hake / other)
- Paper (Fabriano artistico / Fabriano 5 / Arches Platine / Bregger COT / Hahnemuhle Platinum, alternative materials for experimentation with cyanotype)

- Access to water
- Access to a dim room / dim space
- Access to Sunlight or UV light source
- 3 x Trays or dishes (photo specific or old tupperware/pyrex or ceramic baking dishes)
- Contact printing frame or glass and backing with bulldog clips
- Contact printing image source (negatives to size or variety of objects for photograms/shadowgrams)
- Kitchen or other small scale (that can weigh in grams)
- Fairy cups or other small containers to weigh out amounts into
- Drying space
- Storage for prints
- Gloves (kitchen will do but nitrile best)

Optional:

- Clothes to get messy in
- Green tea
- Black tea
- Coffee
- Wine
- Sodium carbonate (soda crystals)
