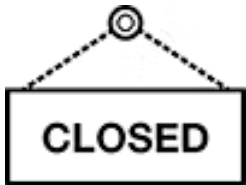

About Stills

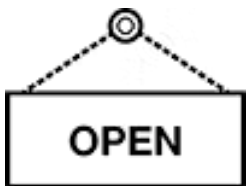
Stills Centre for Photography is a **charity** which includes a gallery, shop, photobooth, library, facilities, courses and an alternative photography school.

Street and front access

Stills is located on 23 Cockburn Street, Edinburgh, EH1 1BP



- Cockburn Street is located across from Waverly Bridge, beside Waverly Station
- The street is on a steep curved hill
- Cars are not allowed to drive up or down the street between 10:30am-6pm
- Any vehicle with a blue badge can drive down the street



- Stills is halfway up Cockburn Street
- The building is painted white with big windows
- The front door is a push to open (it does not open automatically)

Entrance and reception desk

When you come in you'll be greeted at reception.



- The reception desk is in front of the entrance
- Our staff are friendly and welcoming
- If you are taking part in a course or using facilities please let reception know you have arrived



- There is an analogue photobooth beside the reception which is open to members of the public (it's the only one in Scotland!)
- This can make the entrance a little busy sometimes

Through the gallery

Our gallery looks different with each exhibition but there is always ramp and stair access through the space.



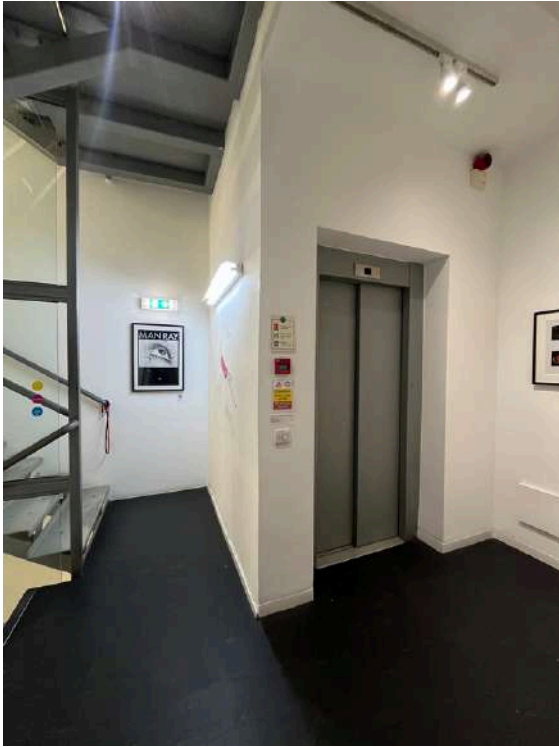
- There are 3 steps into the lower gallery space

There is step free access to all floors via our lift



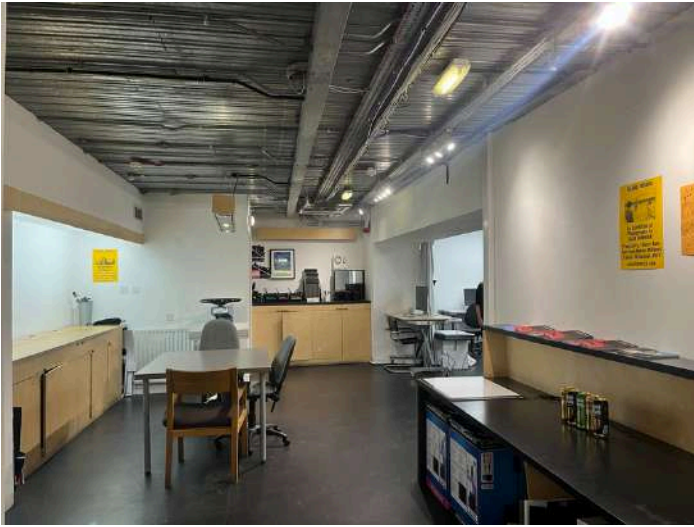
- Outside the lift



- Inside the lift

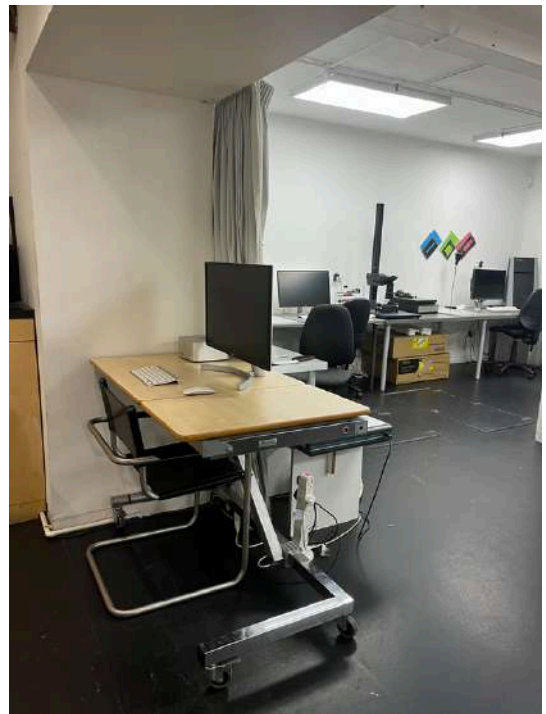
Facilities

Downstairs are facilities. Our **digi lab** is a large space with computers, scanners and printers. This is where course sessions are held.



The digi lab includes:

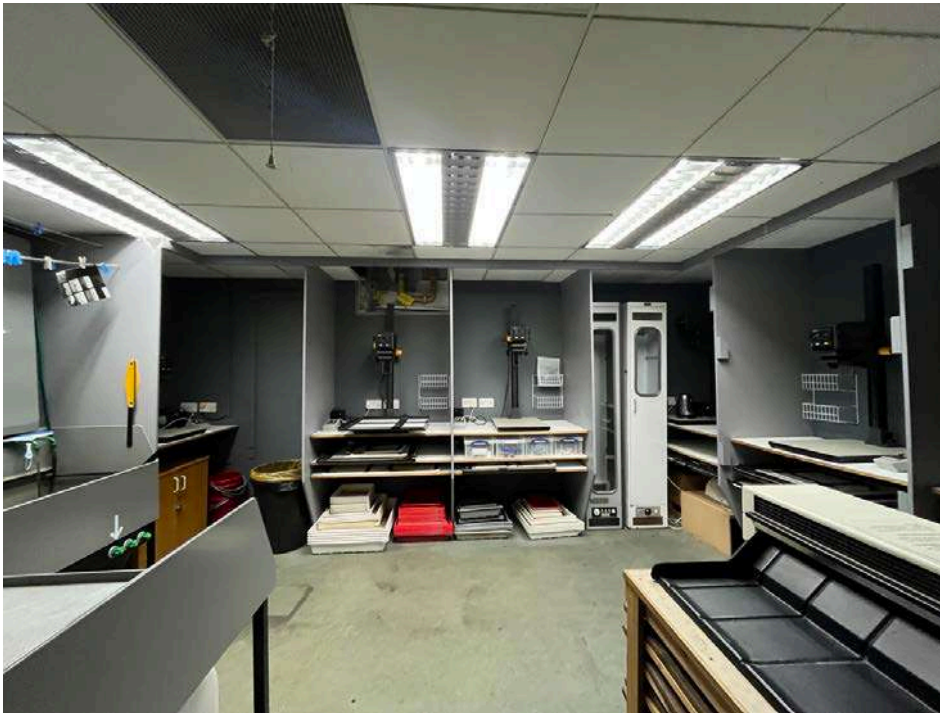
- a large screen

- optional seating



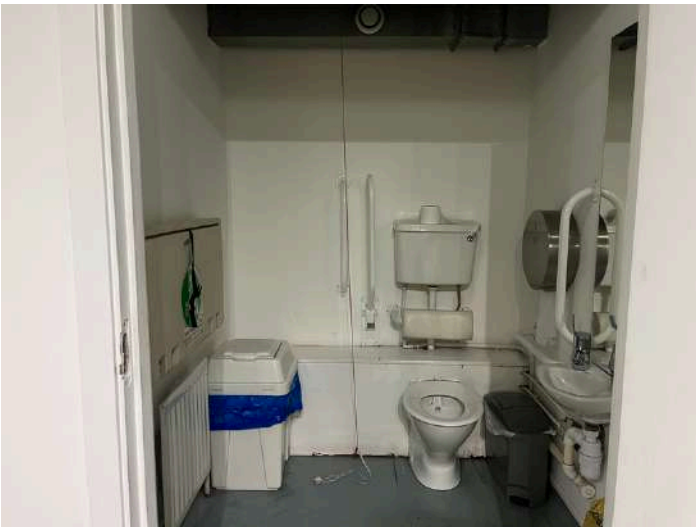

Bathrooms

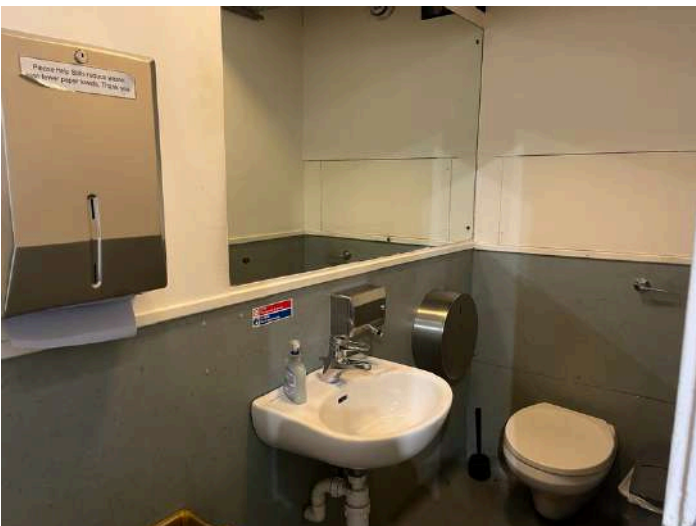
We have 3 individual bathrooms. One is an accessible bathroom with a changing station. All our bathrooms are gender neutral.

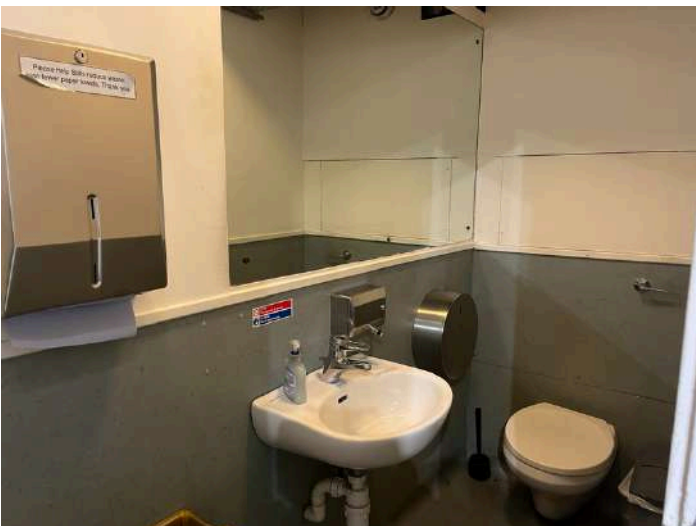
We have 3 individual bathrooms. One is an accessible bathroom with a changing station. All our bathrooms are gender neutral.
